Serenity House is a supportive housing program for 16 homeless, chemically dependent adults. Participants must be motivated to recover from alcohol and/or drug dependency. Professional drug and alcohol counseling and treatment services are offered by a local agency. Participants are expected to progress from a highly structured program to a less restrictive environment leading to maintaining permanent housing, increasing income, and overall self-sufficiency.

Referrals to Serenity House come from the emergency shelter or other homeless providers who have the capacity to certify the individual's homeless status.

Serenity House is located in two shared living facilities located in Sandusky, Ohio. After an individual accomplishes specific elements of their individual service plan he or she is able to move to an independent housing with follow up supportive services available.

Serenity House participants are expected to give back to the community and often assist with the collection and distribution of food for the food pantry and Christmas Food Boxes. Participants are also encouraged to participate in AA/NA/CA meetings or spiritually based programs that support recovery efforts.
